Lautenberg Amendment Disqualification Information/Guidance

AR 601-280, Chapter 3, paragraph 3-9e(12):

Soldiers who are prohibited from possessing firearms or ammunition because of qualifying **conviction for domestic violence under the Lautenberg Amendment** and AR 600-20, paragraph 4-23, are **not eligible to reenlist**. Soldiers identified with a qualifying conviction have an assignment consideration code (ASCO) of "L9" in EDAS. As an exception, Soldiers may request an extension if pending legal action for expunction or pardon, if otherwise qualified. Proof that the Soldier has initiated a request for expunction or pardon will be provided to the servicing Career Counselor prior to the Soldier executing an extension. Reason for extension will be "*In the best interest of the service*" and not exceed 12 months.

AR 601-280, Chapter 4, paragraph 4-9n:

Soldiers affected by the Lautenberg Amendment. Soldiers who are seeking to reenlist and have a qualifying conviction under the Lautenberg Amendment (EDAS ASCO code of "L9"), may not reenlist, but may be processed for an extension if otherwise qualified. Proof that the Soldier has initiated a request for expunction or pardon will be provided to the servicing Career Counselor prior to the Soldier executing the extension. The reason cited on the Oath of Extension of Enlistment will be "Convenience of the Government."
